AGREEMENT

on the Maintenance of Peace and Security Guarantees between the Republic of Moldova and Pridnestrovie

The Republic of Moldova and Pridnestrovie, proceeding from the striving for the soonest possible establishment of mutual measures of confidence, recognizing the need for reconstruction of the bridges, destroyed during the armed conflict, ensuring free movement of citizens and cargos, confirming their commitment to the principles and purposes proclaimed by the UN Charter, OSCE, as well as to the April 28, 1994 Statement of the Sides, recognizing the need for the stage-by-stage program of building and carrying out state-legal relations, meeting the interests of the entire population, have agreed as follows:

- 1. The Republic of Moldova and Pridnestrovie undertake not to use military force in mutual relations and not to put political, economic or other forms of pressure on each other.
- 2. The Sides will refrain from participation on bilateral or multilateral basis in alliances, blocks or other organizations, directed against one of the Sides.
- 3. The Republic of Moldova and Pridnestrovie appeal to the Russian Federation, Ukraine and OSCE to be guarantors of implementation of this agreement.

Made in the city of Tiraspol on July 5,1995.
